**Directions to the Salish Lodge:**

From I-90, take exit 25 towards WA-18 E. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Echo Glen Rd/Snoqualmie Pkwy. Follow for approximately 3.5 miles and turn left onto Railroad Ave. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit to continue onto Railroad Ave/WA-202 W for approximately 0.3 miles. The entrance to Salish Lodge will be on your left, 6501 Railroad Ave NE. Pull up to the front entrance; all cars will be parked by the valet.

From the north, take SR 203 from Duvall or Carnation to the intersection with SR 202 in Fall City. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto WA-202 E, and follow for 3.8 miles. The Salish lodge will be on your right, 6501 Railroad Ave NE. Pull up to the front entrance; all cars will be parked by the valet.
