Little Soos Creek at stream mile 1 runs through the City of Covington's Wingfield Open Space, where it historically has been armored, disconnected from its floodplain, and regularly floods the adjacent trail in winter. Mid Sound Fisheries Enhancement Group has been working with the City of Covington and Herrera on a conceptual design and alternatives analysis for a project that will restore in-stream and floodplain habitat.
