The WRIA 9 Watershed Ecosystem Forum works on salmon recovery in the Green/Duwamish and Central Puget Sound Watershed.

Our work includes improving habitat, water quality, and reducing flood hazards. This improves the health of the watershed and the people who live there.

Applicants must:

- live or attend school within the WRIA 9 Watershed, which includes the Enumclaw, Tahoma, Auburn, Kent, Federal Way, Renton, Highline, Vashon, and Seattle school districts;
- be between the grades of 9 and 12;
- serve for one year; and
- have parent permission if under 18.

Selected Youth Members will receive a \$500 stipend for a one-year term commitment.

All applicants will be considered regardless of race, color, gender, national origin, or ability.
